Admission Policy for Department of Tourism

◆Application Requirements

International 1st-year Student Application ※For exclusive application ONLY

Applicants must have foreign citizenship, be eligible for "College Student" status of residence, and meet all of the following criteria

- ① Able to receive a recommendation from a representative of the educational institutions, such as their home school or a Japanese language education institution.
- ② Individuals applying should exhibit the essential Japanese language proficiency needed for academic endeavors: JLPT N2 or higher on the Japanese Language Proficiency Test, 220 or higher on EJU's Japanese as a Foreign Language test, 600 or higher (A-C Level) on the J.TEST, or NAT-TEST level 2 or higher.
- ③ Completed 12 years of school education in a foreign country, or those who are recognized as having equivalent or better academic ability by the university's admission eligibility screening.

International Transfer 2nd-year Student Application ※For exclusive application ONLY

Applicants must have foreign citizenship, be eligible for "College Student" status of residence, and meet all of the following criteria

- ① Able to receive a recommendation from a representative of the educational institutions, such as their home school or a Japanese language education institution.
- ② Graduates of 2-year or higher universities outside of Japan, or those who have attended such universities for at least 2 years and earned at least 31 credits.
- ③ Individuals applying should exhibit the essential Japanese language proficiency needed for academic endeavors: JLPT N2 or higher on the Japanese Language Proficiency Test, 220 or higher on EJU's Japanese as a Foreign Language test, 600 or higher (A-C Level) on the J.TEST, or NAT-TEST level 2 or higher.
- ④ Completed 12 years of school education in a foreign country, or those who are recognized as having equivalent or better academic ability by the university's admission eligibility screening.

※ However, the minimum period of enrollment and graduation time at the University will vary depending on the length of enrollment and credits earned at your school.

International 1st-year Student Application ※For exclusive application ONLY

Selection will be based on a comprehensive review of the following steps

- ① Documentary screening
- ② Online personal interview
- ③ Essay (Applicants for the designated school or partner school are exempted from the screening process)

※ In principle, the online personal interview (in Japanese) must be conducted at the educational institution where the applicant receives the recommendation.

International Transfer 2nd-year Student Application ※For exclusive application ONLY

Selection will be based on a comprehensive review of the following steps

- ① Documentary screening
- ② Online personal interview
- ③ Essay (Applicants for the designated school or partner school are exempted from the screening process)

※ In principle, the online personal interview (in Japanese) must be conducted at the educational institution where the applicant receives the recommendation.

◆ **Petition Submission Period**

※*Applicants will be screened for eligibility by the University faculties to determine if they are eligible to apply.

【Scholarship Program for International Students】

We provide tuition reductions and exemptions for privately financed international students (who qualified for "College Student" status of residence) who outstands both academically and in character, and who are in financial difficulty. The following procedures and qualifications are required:

- Applicants must submit the "Application Form" designated by the University at the designated time.
- The amount of money sent home (excluding entrance and tuition fees) must be less than the standard amount set by the university (90,000 yen). If the applicant has dependents living in Japan, their annual income must be less than the standard amount specified by the university.
- The applicant must earn the required number of credits each year.
(The tuition reduction rate may decrease depending on the number of credits earned.)

<input type="checkbox"/> Certificate of Enrolment	The applicant must prepare the above document within three months before the submittal of the application. The applicant currently studying at a university, junior college or vocational school must submit the above certificate.
<input type="checkbox"/> Transcript of grades (showing the number of credits)	Preferably prepared within the last three months. Please submit a copy prepared and strictly sealed by the principal of the school from which you graduated. *If you are from a university, junior college, or vocational school outside of Japan and your credits cannot be verified, please submit a high school graduation certificate with your transcript.

- The applicant shall submit the certificates and other documents in languages other than Japanese or English with Japanese translation.
- Once the applicant submits the documents, the University will not return those documents unless the University recognises specific reasons or issues.
- At the time of the enrolment procedure, the applicant shall submit the written pledge if a case arises in which the applicant cannot enter Japan.
- Once the University accepts the exclusive admission applicant to enter, the applicant cannot withdraw from the admission.
- When the applicant cannot meet the basic application and eligibility requirements by the end of September 2024, the University will terminate the applicant's admission progress.
